Shinei Miura has taken the best attributes from our favorite Miura irons and combines them into one refined package that will appeal to a wide range of players. In a day and age when many clubs want to do one or two things, the TC-202 irons are for the player who wants to hit every shot.

The TC-202 continues Miura's tradition of balancing muscle-back precision with cavity-back forgiveness. Built on insights from professionals, top amateurs, and launch data, the TC-202 refines the success of its predecessor, the TC-201. Key improvements include center mass weight distribution, inspired by the Miura CB-57, ensuring a solid impact feel, stability, and maneuverability.

THE T-WEIGHT BAR



A critical enhancement to the TC-202 is the T-Weight Bar, which reintroduces center mass distribution. This innovation optimizes weight placement throughout the set, enhancing trajectory control, spin consistency, and forgiveness.

The ubiquitous feel of Miura irons is prominent in the TC 202. The precision of the T-Weight Bar delivers a powerful sound and feel.

The T-Weight Bar in the TC-202 also features a variable depth cavity throughout, making each iron, from the 3-iron to the gap wedge, unique and optimized for each specific shot.

Long Irons: Lower center of gravity improves forgiveness.

Mid Irons: Greater cavity presence enhances feel and control.

Short Irons: Precision weighting enables trajectory and distance control akin to muscle-backs.

THE SOLE



The Y-Grind (named after Yoshitaka Miura) returns as a key feature of the TC-202. The sole design comes from the years of feedback and lessons learned from watching and talking to golfers of all skill levels.

Golfers will see a grind with optimized width, including leading and trailing edge relief, resulting in efficient and powerful turf interaction and more importantly, a club head delivered to square at impact.

THE PROGRESSION



While modern technology has given us weight screws, multi-materials, hollow bodied irons, and more, the TC-202 is able to deliver high performance from a traditional looking set. Classic looks combine with the sound and feel enhancing Miura Golf's renowned reputation.

TC-202 FAQ

Q: What are the differences between the TC-201 and the TC-202?

A: The TC-202 builds on the TC-201 by introducing the T-Weight Bar, optimizing weight distribution for improved trajectory control, spin consistency, and forgiveness. The center of gravity (CG) has been lowered in the long irons and raised in the scoring clubs, creating more consistent shot flight throughout the set. It also features a variable depth cavity, ensuring each iron is uniquely designed for its role—including the first-ever gap wedge in this category. Additionally, the Y-Grind (named after Yoshitaka Miura) sole, shaped by years of player feedback, enhances turf interaction and promotes a square clubface at impact.

Q: How does the weight and shape of the Miura TC-202 irons contribute to performance?

A: The Miura TC-202 irons are crafted with precision, achieving a +/- tolerance of .5 grams in the club head. This ensures optimal weight distribution and density control, contributing to consistent performance and exceptional feel. The clean, classic look of the TC-202 helps golfers develop confidence, while the leading edge Y-Grind sole promotes enhanced turf interaction that encourages consistency.

Q: Are the Miura TC-202 irons available for left-handed golfers?

A: Currently, the Miura TC-202 irons are available only for right-handed golfers. Stay tuned, as there are some exciting developments in the works for our left-handed Miura players!

Q: Are the Miura TC-202 irons available in Black QPQ?

A: Not currently. However, we plan to introduce more finish options in the future. Stay tuned for updates on new finishes that will be available for the Miura TC-202 irons.

Q: How does the offset/face progression of the TC-202 compare to the TC-201?

A: The offset/face progression of the TC-202 has remained the same as TC-201, ensuring a consistent top-line appearance, feel and performance that players have come to appreciate.

Q: What type of player would play the TC-202?

A: The TC-202 is ideal for players who seek a forged iron with a larger sweet spot for added forgiveness, while still maintaining the sleek aesthetics of the TC-201. It is well-suited for golfers from mid-handicaps to low single-digit handicaps, offering a more consistent shot flight throughout the set. With the strategically positioned center of gravity (CG) and T-bar design, the TC-202 helps players achieve a more consistent ball strike, particularly with the long irons, while still delivering the performance and feel expected from a Miura iron.

Q: Why is the leading-edge grind good for players and which type of player benefits?

A: The Y Grind, with its soft leading edge, enhances turf interaction and shot-making capabilities for golfers at all skill levels. The design allows for better control and consistent contact, particularly when playing from various lies, without compromising the bounce of the club. Advanced players benefit from the ability to manipulate the club face, giving them confidence to shape shots with precision. Golfers at any level can appreciate the improved turf interaction the Y Grind offers.
